Bottom Line

From what I can tell, Viper is an application that feeds into a Web service. Why it needs a downloaded app when the real work takes place online is unclear, but it seems likely that the problems are with the server end, not the app itself (other than the installation issues).

If they can correct their server problems, Viper has a lot of potential for doing decent plagiarism checking.

However, for students seriously worried about their papers, would urge you to go ahead and spend the small amount of money and use [WriteCheck](#). Not only does it use the same database as most colleges and high schools, the Turnitin one, it doesn't index your paper and it has access to private libraries and collections Viper can't see. Furthermore, the matching technology, while imperfect, seems to be better.
